For the second time, Haus am Maiberg and Interactive organize training for facilitators of youth projects. It is open for people having experience in working with youth and are willing to discuss principals and methods of non-formal education in youth work. The training provides places for sixteen participants from Germany and Russia. The project aims to empower young people to facilitate especially in youth exchanges in the future. Previous experience in facilitating is welcomed but not mandatory.
