Today

- Produce
 - River fish, various fruits, berries, vegetables, flowers and vegetable oil
- Industry
 - Center for production of helicopters and farm machinery
 - Rostov nuclear power plant

Most important factories

- Rostvertol
 - founded in 1939 by a decree of the Soviet government
 - Producing civilian and military helicopters



Earlier in History

✓ Favorable geographical position as a trading crossroad

✓ River connection to Russia's interior

✓ Trading port for Russian, Italian, Greek and Turkish merchants

Today

- Transport
 - "Gateway to the Caucasus"
 - Airport: - built in 1925, international airport since 1986
 - in 2011 it handled 1.716.200 passengers



Most important factories

- Rostselmash
 - Founded in 1929
 - produces 18 types and over 100 models of agricultural machinery
 - Biggest company of its kind in Russia and eastern Europe.



Earlier in History

- Heavy industry developed since 1846
- In the 20th century the heaviest industrialized city in southern Russia

Today

- Volga - Don - Canal
 - Types of Cargo:
 - Coal from Donezk
 - Minerals
 - Building materials
 - Grain
 - Petroleum products
 - In the first 55 years 50.000 vessels passed through
 - 12 million tons of cargo every year



Most important factories

- Yug Rusi
 - produces food, especially sunflower oil
 - Rostov oil extraction plant is the largest in Europe
